### **Oklahoma Man Arrested for Deceptive Trade Practices Violations**

PIERRE, S.D. – Attorney General Marty Jackley announced today that Willie Buck Stanley Jr., 43, Spiro, Oklahoma was indicted yesterday on 1 count each of failure to inform buyer of their right to cancel and failure to furnish cancellation form, class 6 felonies, punishable by up to 2 years in the penitentiary and/or \$4,000 fine.

Charges stem from an asphalt paving job Stanley conducted in Lawrence County. Stanley was operating under the business name W. Stanley Paving

The Attorney General's Consumer Protection Division is working with local authorities to determine if there are additional victims.
